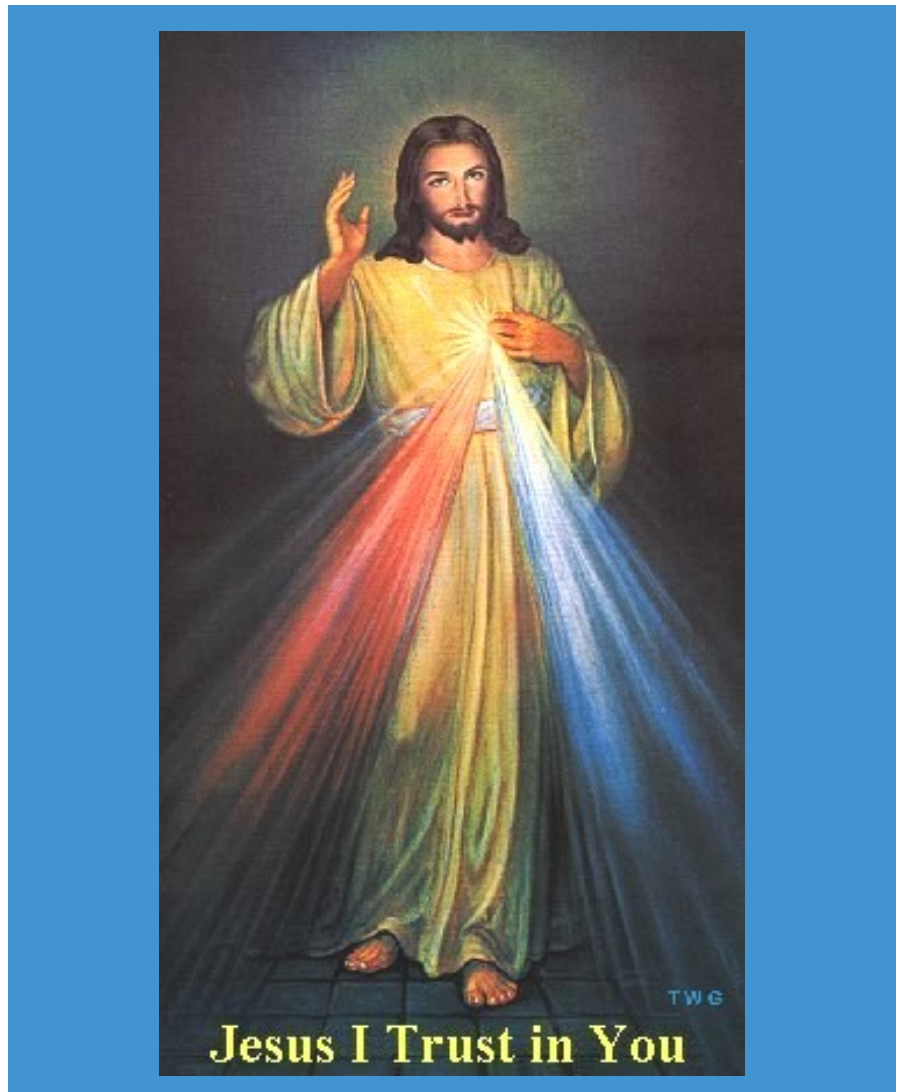

Homily Series Week I: One Church, One Mission

Dear Friends in Christ,

This week we are kicking off a very important homily series titled *One Church, One Mission*. In 2016 Sacred Heart Parish journeyed through a time of discernment we called *Alive in Christ (AIC)*. Through a series of discussions with hundreds of participants, the Holy Spirit guided us in discerning our essential mission - *Walking With You To Meet Jesus*. The core purpose of our parish is to accompany others toward an encounter with Christ and a personal acceptance of salvation through Him.

From AIC, the Parish Pastoral Council identified nine pastoral priorities to unite and guide is on our mission. One of the major priorities was becoming One Church. This also happens to be one of the main priorities of the Archdiocesan Pastoral Vision.

Many people voiced a desire to see our parish live in greater unity instead of two parishes separated by language. We thank you for the feedback you shared through our survey last month regarding your experiences with bilingual worship. Although our goal is about more than just bilingual Mass, we do believe that the next step the Lord is calling us to is to join together in worship as a people.

I invite you to take a few minutes and read the Pastoral Letter you received from Fr. Scott and me in the mail this week. Along with the homily series, we hope to help our community prepare for this visionary and exciting way of life so that we can be One Church united for One Mission.
