### 5th Sunday in Lent

#### Homily Message: Preparing for the Passion

#### Dear Friends in Christ,

Welcome to Sacred Heart Parish. Norfolk is a busy crossroads. We welcome guests who have come from both near and far. Thanks for being here.

This weekend begins a period of preparation for the Holy Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday) call "Passiontide". The atmosphere in our churches becomes more subdued as we cover statues and move the crucifix to the front and center position at St. Mary's.

From now until Good Friday our liturgical life begins a gradual "dying" process. The holy liturgy is God's way of allowing us to encounter him and receive his life. Without the liturgy we have no physical access to the Lord. We feel this most acutely on Good Friday, the only day of the year when Mass is not celebrated, and the tabernacle is empty. You can literally feel the Lord's absence.

Whatever we have experienced during Lent up to this point prepares us to live the glory of the Passion. If Lent has not been great for you don't worry, just begin again. Jesus takes any open heart available to him. These are the days that change lives. Come, let's walk with Jesus to glory!

We will be hosting a Parish clean up day next Saturday to get our two churches and the immediate grounds around them ready for Holy Week guests. Then, on April 27th, we will join the Norfolk Chamber for a community clean-up day. Please see the details in this bulletin and join in to help if you can.

This weekend we're providing another financial update. Thank you for stepping up to the plate by using automatic withdrawal for sacrificial giving. It makes such a huge difference in your parish's cash flow. Thanks also to anyone who has put forward an extraordinary gift to help us finish the fiscal year without borrowing any more money. Every gift helps!

We thank parishioners in the 5 parish area (Norfolk, Madison, Stanton, Schoolcraft, Battle Creek) who have filled out the Mass time survey. The number of responses has been robust. It provides the data needed to make the best decision for this new way of life in our region of the Archdiocese. Keep in mind that the goal is not just for the Church to survive but to *thrive* as we go out of our doors to make disciples.

#### Mensaje de homilía: Preparándose para la Pasión

#### Queridos amigos en Cristo,

Bienvenidos la Parroquia del Sagrado Corazón. Norfolk es una ciudad ocupada. Le damos la bienvenida a los invitados que han venido de cerca y de lejos. Gracias por estar aquí.

Este fin de semana comienza el periodo de preparación para el Santo Triduo (Jueves, Viernes y Sábado Santo) llamado "Passiontide". El ambiente en nuestras Iglesias se vuelve más tenue mientras cubrimos estatuas y movemos el crucifijo al frente y centro en la posición de Santa María.

Desde ahora hasta el Viernes Santo, en nuestra vida litúrgica comienza un proceso gradual de "muerte". La santa liturgia es la manera que Dios nos permite encontrarnos con él y recibir su vida. Sin la liturgia no tendríamos acceso físico al Señor. Sentimos esto más intensamente el Viernes Santo, el único día del año que la misa no se celebra, el tabernáculo está vacío. Literalmente puedes sentir la ausencia del Señor.

Todo lo que hemos experimentado durante la cuaresma, hasta este punto nos prepara para vivir para la Gloria de la Pasión. Si la cuaresma no ha sido buena para ti, no te preocupes, solo comienza otra vez. Jesús toma cualquier corazón abierto que está disponible para él. Estos son los días para cambiar vidas. ## Help us offer our Gratitude through Project Homeless Connect – Special Collection April 6/7

Each Spring and Fall we hold a second collection for a Missions Project (purple envelope in Feb/March your packets), so that our entire parish has an opportunity to express their gratitude and offer the Mercy of God to those in need. In the past our Spring collection has supported a mission trip to the Mustard Seed Community in Jamaica. Since we have not scheduled a mission trip this year, we will be offering our spring Mission collection to help a local community-led event, called Project Homeless Connect.

Project Homeless Connect will be held on **Friday, June 28, 2019** and is a one stop, one day event providing immediate access to multiple services for the homeless and near homeless in the surrounding area. Last year, Sacred Heart Norfolk volunteers manned a mobile food pantry that provided over 20,000 pounds of food to over 350 guests (You might have seen the pictures)! We were blown away and have offered our assistance in providing this service again this year.

**How can You help?**

- Make a donation this weekend to help cover costs of the food as well as other services being offered. The local PHC team’s goal is to have sponsorships of \$25,000 to provide for the event.
- We will be opening the Volunteer Registration to help with the Mobile Food Pantry on May 1<sup>st</sup>. Deb Haselhorst and our parish food pantry ministry will coordinate volunteer registrations to help with that area.
