Message Series, Week 2 of 3: **MASS EFFECT**

This week Deacon Bill Cremers will focus on the effect the Word of God has had in his personal relationship with Christ and his vocational discernment.

To latch on to one word or phrase in the readings that speaks to my heart and a personal need I have.

Dear Friends in Christ,

Welcome to Sacred Heart Parish. We wish you the peace of Jesus Christ. Whether you live near or far, know that your presence is a gift to us.

We welcome Deacon Bill Cremers, a seminarian who will be with us for the summer. Deacon Cremers is from Columbus and will be ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Omaha next Summer. Deacon Bill will be offering the homily this weekend.

MASS EFFECT

This weekend we continue with week 2 of 3 week homily series called *Mass Effect*. The Mass is central to our lives as Catholics. It's the place where we "pass over" from a life of sin and death to the life of the Kingdom through the sacrifice of Jesus.

To kick off our series last week Fr. Scott talked about the Penitential Rite at the beginning of Mass as the gateway for receiving the gifts God offers. This week we focus on the Word of God and how this part of the Mass can bring power and purpose to our lives.

Each weekend we are presented with a healthy portion of Scripture. Honestly, it's almost too much to process without some sort of preparation. Though the homily is crucial, the best thing any one of us can do is pray with the readings at least once before coming to pray on the weekend. God has way of speaking to us as we sit with His Word.

With this little bit of preparation and an open (and hungry) heart we gradually come to a greater understanding of who God is, what he wants for us, and how he'll make it happen. I'm sure there are certain scriptures that you have latched on to because at some point they spoke a truth that you wanted or needed to hear. That's what God wants. Words have the power to move. God's Word has the power to move mountains.

Next week, I'll finish the series by talking about the real importance of each and every person at Mass.

Para patear nuestra serie la semana pasada, el P. Scott habló sobre el Rito Penitencial al comienzo de la Misa como la puerta de entrada para recibir los dones que Dios ofrece. Esta semana nos enfocamos en la Palabra de Dios y cómo esta parte de la Misa puede traer poder y propósito a nuestras vidas.

Cada fin de semana se nos presenta una porción saludable de las Escrituras. Honestamente, es casi demasiado procesar sin algún tipo de preparación. 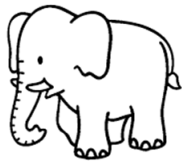
