Middle Schoolers Need Your Involvement More Than Ever

Middle-Schoolers often tell parents, "Stay away from school!" But the truth is, they need (and want) their parents' involvement and support more than ever.

1. Often tell your child you care about his/her education.
2. Let him/her know you expect him/her to do well in school.
3. Find out about homework, discipline and other school policies and rules.
4. Keep up-to-date on your child's progress in school.
5. Know your child's school schedule.
6. Talk with your child about school regulations.
7. Be aware of what your child is learning.
8. Listen to your middle-schoolers' concerns.
9. Help your child deal with problems as they arise.
10. Be available to take care of problems and reassure your child.
11. Stay in contact with teachers and others at school.
12. Talk with counselors about courses your child should take to prepare for college.
13. Attend Parent-Teacher Conferences.
14. Review report cards.
15. If your child isn't learning, get extra help.
16. Promote good study habits.
17. Limit your child's TV and cell phone time.
18. Provide adequate after school supervision.
19. Join the parent-teacher association.
20. Get to know your child's friends and their parents.
